

Welcome to Equinor in the Netherlands



General Information

The Equinor office is conveniently located near Rotterdam Central (Stationsplein exit). The office address is:

Weena 760 (8th floor)
3014 DA Rotterdam

Equinor core hours of operation are Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Access at any other time (internal or external visitors) needs to be prearranged with your Equinor host or Equinor reception.

Signing in at the reception

Visitors first need to check in at the reception desk on the ground floor of the building.

There you will be issued a building badge which will give you access to the elevators to the 8th floor.

In our office, non-Equinor visitors must present picture identification and will be issued a Equinor visitor's badge. Non-Equinor visitors must be escorted by an employee while in the Equinor office.

Visitor badges must be returned to the reception in the office when leaving, while the building badge needs to be returned to the reception at the ground floor.

Security

Visitor badges must be worn and clearly visible at all times.

Photography and filming on the premises are prohibited without authorization.

Electronic devices may not be connected to the Equinor network without authorization.

Smoking policy

Smoking is prohibited at the Equinor facility and the building, except in designated areas outside the building.

Luggage

Luggage and coats can be stored in the designated area in the office and are the visitor's responsibility.

If you need assistance, please ask the Equinor receptionist.

Parking

Onsite parking is not available.

There is a paid public parking close to the office: Schouwburgplein 2 – Weenatunnel 50 – 3013 AL Rotterdam

Canteen/restaurants

Evacuation routes and assembly points

Emergency exits are in the northeast and southeast corners of the floor and marked with green emergency exit signs in the ceiling. Evacuation route diagrams are posted next the stairwell exits.



In case of fire

- Call 112
- Evacuate the building and follow instructions from fire wardens and/or announcements.
- Do not use elevators.
- Do not return to the building until it is declared safe.

Medical emergency/ First Aid

In case of medical emergency, immediately call 112.

First aid kit and defibrillator are located near the large meeting room.

Safety and security checklist:

- I know where the emergency exits are.
- I know the number to call in an emergency.
- My visitor badge is visible to those around me.
- I have the authority to stop any work I see that I consider unsafe.
- I report safety hazards to my host or reception.
