General Information

This Equinor office is conveniently located in the EU neighborhood next to the Schuman square and the EU institutions.

The site is accessible by bike or public transport. Schuman metro and train station is 850 m from the office and Brussels Airport is less than 20 minutes away depending on traffic.

Equinor core hours of operation are Monday-Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Access at any other time (internal or external visitors) needs to be prearranged with your Equinor host or Equinor reception.

Signing in at the reception

Visitors first need to check in at our reception desk.

In our office, non-Equinor visitors must present picture identification and will be issued a Equinor visitor's badge.

Non-Equinor visitors must be escorted by an employee while in the Equinor office.

Visitor badges must be returned to the reception when leaving.

Security

Visitor badges must be worn and clearly visible at all times

Photography and filming on the premises are prohibited without authorization.

Electronic devices may not be connected to the Equinor network without authorization.

Smoking policy

Smoking is prohibited at the Equinor facility and the building, except in designated areas outside the building.

Luggage

Luggage and coats can be stored in the designated area in the office and are the visitor's responsibility.

If you need assistance, please ask the Equinor receptionist.

Parking

On site parking is not available for guests, but parking is available in the neighboring streets for a fee at parking meters.

Canteen/restaurants
